Our mission is to build a network of social purpose consultants to provide capacity-building support to organizations and institutions serving Black, Indigenous, and racialized communities.






MEMBERSHIP

- Increase networking opportunities




FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

REVENUE PERCENTAGE


Please find revenue generation by category for the year.
